Date: August 7-8th 2010. Start time 9am. Mandatory riders meeting 8:30am both days. Last rider out 9:30am.

Start: Fireman's Field, Park St, Hancock, NY 13783. NY-17 (Future I-86) to Hancock Exit 87, or NY 97 into Hancock & follow arrows.

Sign-up: Open Fri. 4-7pm; Sat. 6-9am & 3-6pm for Sun.; Sun. 6-9am. **PRE-ENTER!** By mailing completed entry form below with check or money order. **Pre-entries must be received by 7/31. CASH ONLY AT SIGN-UP FRIDAY, SATURDAY, SUNDAY!**

Requirements: All entrants must be 18 years or older and a member of American Motorcyclist Association. Get your AMA membership in advance; there will be very limited AMA memberships available at the event. **Route-sheet holder required, for dual sport and adventure ride: YOU WILL NEED IT!** Motorcycle drivers license, valid license plate mounted on drop-down fender, vehicle registration, proof of insurance, NO BOGUS PAPER WORK! Spark arrestor/muffler 96DB MAX!. WORKING headlight and taillight as required per NY State law. Adventure bikes must be 100% street legal - you will be on public roads in NY & PA – avoid equipment violations. Adv. bikes should have a range of at least 100 miles before reserve. Obey ALL local traffic laws! The fine folks of Hancock are lending us their land to use for the weekend, so let's be courteous and as unobtrusive as possible so we are invited back.

Terrain: Dual sport: There will be lots of new trails and prime woods roads, plus sections and grass track from our upcoming two day National Enduro; bypass areas for hero sections and minimum asphalt. Adventure ride course will be mostly separate from the dual sport course, catering toward larger bikes with dirt roads and secluded scenic back roads, some trails and woods roads.

Food & Beverage: Lunch Saturday at Art's camp in Tar Hollow. Sunday Chicken BBQ included with entry. Breakfast, food and beverage available at the start.

Camping: Available at start field August 6-7-8 for \$10 fee payable to Hancock Fire Dept. No water/power hookups. Bathrooms available. Campsite is right on the Delaware River – Come early and get a good camping spot near the river.
